

Side Tilt Carriages

Side Tilt Carriage - There are 4 sizings of hook type blade carriages rated by the fork carriage hoisting capability. Hook type tine carriages have been the same.

The carriage bar spacing used for Class 1 is approximately thirteen inches and the Class 1 carriage is rated to carry cargo up to 2000lbs. The Class 2 carriage is rated to carry loads up to 5,500lbs with carriage bar spacing of 16 inches. Class III carriages are rated for loads as much as 10,000 lbs. The carriage bar spacing for this class is 20 inches. Class IV carriages are rated for loads up to 15,500 lbs. The carriage bar spacing for this capacity is twenty five inches.

The carriages for pin type blades can be different depending on the manufacturer. Pin mounted blades could vary by the amount of offset between the blade eye and the tine. Carriage capacity will be determined by the carriage pin size and by the blade size.
